## First A4D Board Elected

St. Vincent's Cathedral—Bedford Texas

After over a year of hard work the Advisory Council delegates approved the National A4D's Articles of Incorporation and By-laws in addition to electing the first National Board of Directors. The newly formed national organization will be incorporated as a non-profit in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Elected to the National Board of Directors were: Ken Herbst of Pittsburgh, President; Kat Murchison of Montgomery, VP.; Christine Miller of Bakersfield, Intercessor; The Rev. James McCaslin of Jacksonville, Spiritual Director.; and The Rev. John Nuzum of Northern VA, Secretary.

The Board had its first teleconference meeting on Friday, October 9th.

### A4D Handbook

The National organization has approved an A4D Handbook that is available as a PDF file on the fourth day web site. The Handbook is revised periodically to reflect any changes in the guidelines as outlined in the book.

### Talk Outlines

The National A4D Board encourages all fourth day organizations to use purchased Cursillo talk outlines as long as copyright laws are not violated. Talks should be reviewed and presented to the weekend spiritual director and the team for comment prior to be given during a three-day weekend.
